**Entry fee includes a FREE pass to the Pipe Band Party at Seton High School following the parade!!**

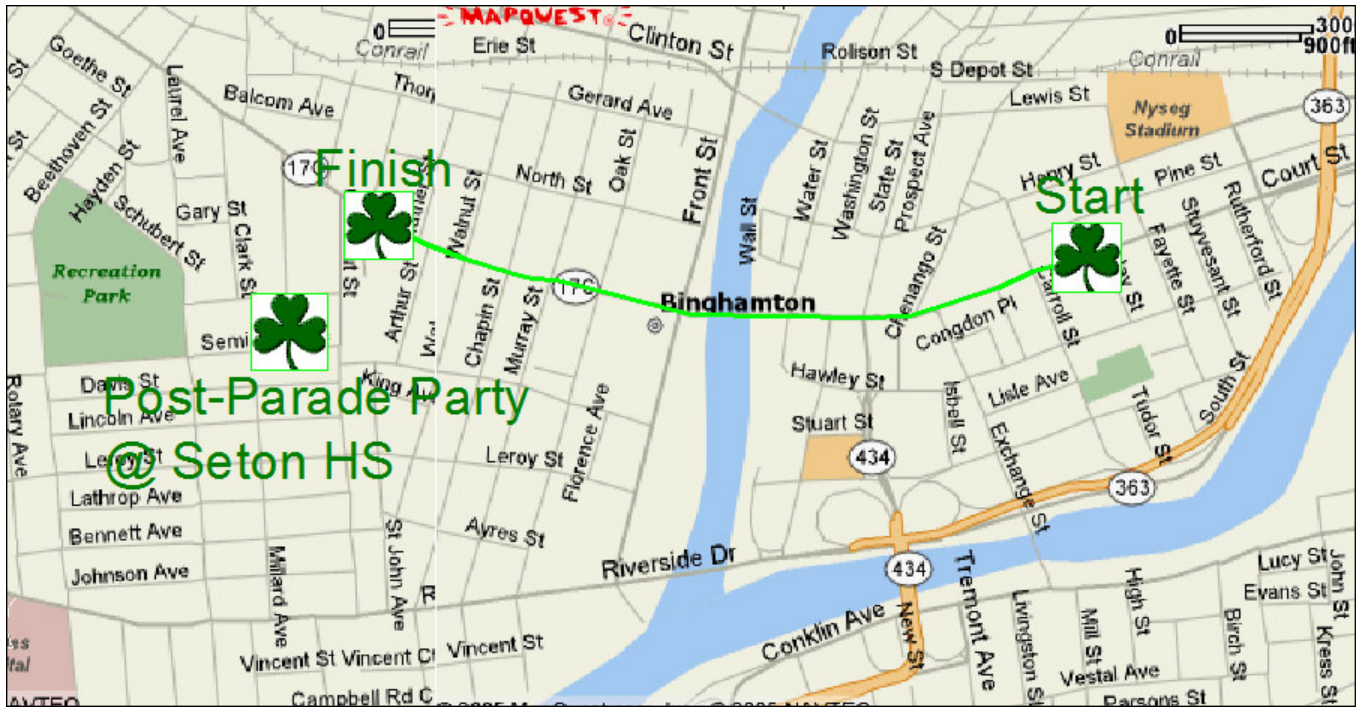
