2. Election of Board Members – Greg Amend, Grace TabEEK, and Ed Jenner were elected to the board for 2009  
Election of Officers – All of the present officers ran again, unopposed, for 2009: President – Tom Carter; Vice President – George Joseph; Secretary – Debbie Grassi; Treasurer – Kevin Pasterchik
3. Robert’s Run 5K – Katie Mower gave information on this new race to be held on May 30 in Conklin, 10:00 am. It will honor a Susquehanna Valley Middle School student who died suddenly before Christmas. TCRC will do insurance and finish line for the race.
4. Snow Fever Run, Walk, and Roll 5K – Jeanne Johnson gave information on this new race to be held on September 26 at Otsiningo Park. It is a community awareness event sponsored by the adaptive snow sports program at Greek Peak. TCRC will do insurance and finish line for the race.
5. The Human Race 5K – Megan Cordi would like to have a race on July 18 at Highland Park to raise money to fight cancer. TCRC will do insurance and finish line for the race.
6. Secretary’s Report – Tom Carter moved to accept the minutes from the January 6, 2009, meeting; Brendan Flynn seconded. The minutes were approved.
8. Treasurer’s Report – Kevin Pasterchik distributed copies of the report and explained expenditures, revenue, tentative budget, projected races, etc. Tom Carter moved to accept the report; Dan Dougherty seconded. Report approved.
7. RRCA Convention – Tony Mazza suggested that the TCRC look into requesting that Binghamton be considered for a site for the annual RRCA Convention. Tony asked that a committee be formed to investigate the possibility. The application must be submitted by October. Byron LaBare offered to assist Tony on a committee. Information will also be posted on the TCRC website to see if anyone else might be interested in helping out.
8. Race Computer Scoring – Much discussion took place concerning finish line scoring, computer programs, purchasing a “chip” system, etc., to make the finish line more efficient. Fran Fitch and Suzanne Myette offered to research available programs, scanners, pricing and present to Board.
9. Bib Numbers – George Joseph requested that the TCRC purchase more bib numbers for the Wednesday night track meets and for the January Freeze 10K

- Series. Tom Carter moved to purchase 1,000 bib numbers; Grace Tabeek seconded. Approved.
10. Dick's 5K – Tom Hamlin would like to bring the race back. Tom Carter will contact someone he knows at Dick's for details.
  11. Digital Recorder – Grace Tabeek purchased a digital voice recorder for the TCRC that she would like to use at races.
  12. Scholarship 8K Run – Grace Tabeek said that the race is May 17. More information to follow.
