**Entry Fee:** \$10.00 with pre-registration (received by June 14). **TCRC members may deduct \$2.00 if they pre-register.** You can also register by searching for "Vestal XX" online at [RunSignUp.com](http://RunSignUp.com). Race day registration is available for an entry fee of \$14.00. Make check in the amount for entry fee plus contribution (see below) payable to "VESTAL XX." Entry fee is waived for any past winner, male or female, of the Vestal XX or any runner 19 years of age or younger.

**Awards:** Ceremony begins at 10:30 AM. Instead of giving awards in age-groups, awards will be given based on "age and gender grading." This works by determining each finisher's performance level based on tables developed by Alan Jones and Rex Harvey for the **World Masters Athletics (WMA)** and the **United States Track and Field Federation (USATF)**. The performance level is a percentage based on world records for the age and gender of the runner.

I know that running a road race is a potentially hazardous activity which could cause injury or death. I should not enter and run unless I am medically able and properly trained, and by my signature, I certify that I am medically able to perform this event, am in good health, and am properly trained. I agree to abide by any decision of a race official relative to any aspect of my participation in this event, including the right of any official to deny or suspend my participation for any reason whatsoever. I assume all risks associated with running this event, including high heat and/or humidity, traffic and the conditions of the road, all such risks being known and appreciated by me. I acknowledge that my entry fee is non-refundable, including if the race is cancelled because of an act of nature.

I understand that the use of bicycles, skate boards, baby joggers or carriages, roller skates or blades, or animals are not allowed in any TCRC event and their use can result in disqualification from a race. I will abide by and assist in the enforcement of this guideline.

Having read this waiver and knowing these facts and in consideration of your accepting my entry, I, for myself and anyone entitled to act on my behalf, waive and release the Triple Cities Runners Club (TCRC), Road Runners Club of America, Dick's Clothing and Sporting Goods, Broome County Trophies and Awards, the Vestal Central School District and the Town of Vestal, their representatives and successors from all claims or liabilities of any kind arising out of my participation in this event, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the sponsoring bodies.

This release shall be binding upon my heirs, administrators, successors and assigns and those of the sponsoring organization. By this release I fully intend to discharge the said organizations from any and all injuries or losses suffered by me while participating in and traveling to and from this event.

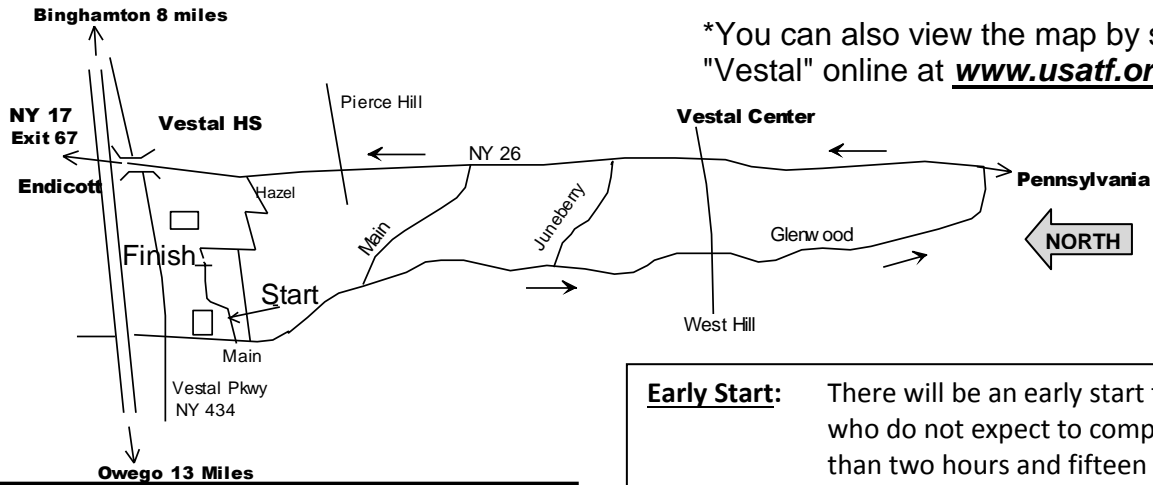

## Early Start:

There will be an early start for those runners who do not expect to complete the race in less than two hours and fifteen minutes. The spirit of the early start is to allow slower runners to finish with the pack and join in with the post-race festivities. To participate, sign up at the registration table on race day by 7:10 AM for the 7:30 AM start. **Please note that early starters are not eligible for awards.**

## Water Stops:

There will be water at approximately every 2 miles with Gatorade at 10K and 15K. Water stations close at 10:00 AM.

## Finish Line:

The finish line officially closes at 10:30 AM. This is a 12:00 minute/mile pace for the normal start and a 14:30 minute/mile pace for the early start.

## Post Race:
